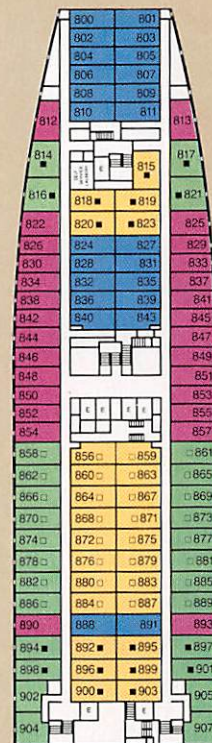

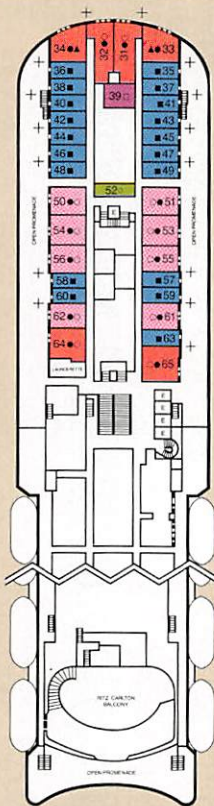
SS ROTTERDAM DECK PLANS



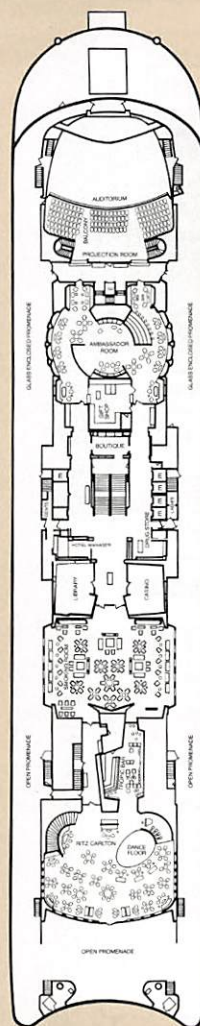

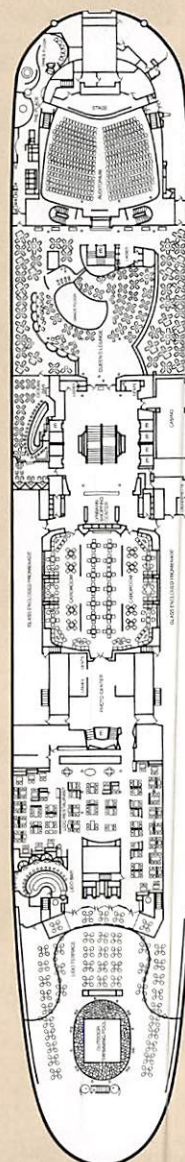

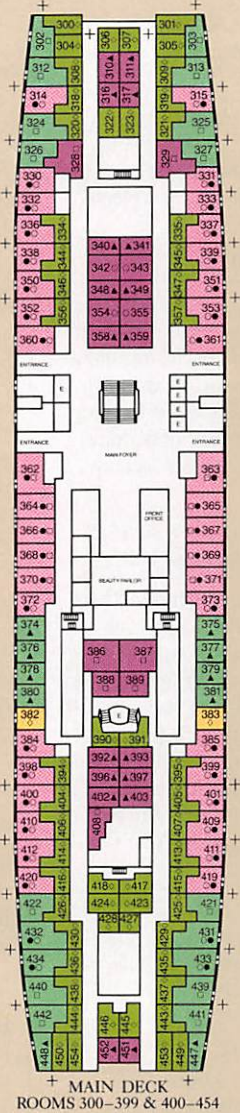

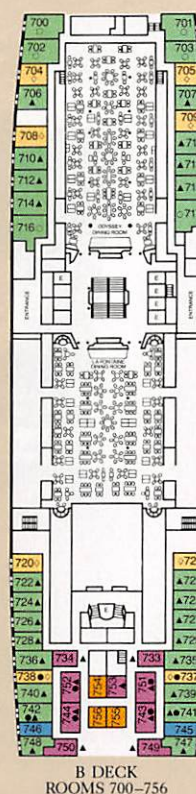

OPTIONAL TOURS

ADDITIONAL ALASKAN EXPERIENCES.

For 37 years we have been helping people enjoy Alaska. Our experience also tells us that you may want to add an optional excursion to your existing tour. In 1984, we offer the following optional tours. Most are available for purchase en route. However, to ensure availability, advance reservations are recommended.

All tour prices include transportation and sightseeing as described, and shared hotel accommodations on overnight tours. Not included are meals, tips, and items of a personal nature. *Rates are per person.* Single hotel rooms, at a supplementary charge, may be requested (but are not guaranteed) on the Arctic Adventure Tour and the Columbia Glacier Tour. If not available on arrival, an appropriate refund will be made for the difference in room rates. Single rooms are not available on the Pribilof Island Tour.

FROM ANCHORAGE:

The following optional overnight tours generally require one additional night Anchorage accommodations when added to an Alaska tour itinerary.

ARCTIC ADVENTURE TOUR TO NOME AND KOTZEBUE (OVERNIGHT NOME)

Daily: May 28-June 15

Note: Some departures may operate in reverse. All sightseeing and events are included in either itinerary.

DAY 1:

Jet across the Arctic Circle to Kotzebue, where your tour includes the Living Museum of the Arctic, blanket toss demonstration, sod house, and Reindeer corral. Then fly to Nome for an overnight.



DAY 2:

In Nome, learn the story of the King Island Eskimos. See a gold mine and pan for gold. Visit the Arctic Trading Post museum. See a real dogsled and an Eskimo skin boat. Shop for Eskimo handicrafts before returning to Anchorage.

DAY 1:

Fly to the Pribilof Islands in the Bering Sea for a unique view of one of the greatest displays of wildlife on earth. Transfer to your hotel on St. Paul Island. Visit the Aleut community and see the old Russian Orthodox Church.

DAY 2 AND ADDITIONAL DAYS:

Thrill to the sight of more than a million fur seals in this international wildlife sanctuary. Visit the sea bird rookeries, where more than 180 bird species have been sighted. Tour the tundra with its wild flowers, Arctic fox and reindeer. Return to Anchorage via Reeve Aleutian Airways.

COLUMBIA GLACIER CRUISE/TOUR

DAY 1. VALDEZ:

A Westours motorcoach takes you east through the rich farmlands of the Matanuska Valley, then south through beautiful Keystone Canyon to the port city of Valdez and your overnight accommodations.

DAY 2. COLUMBIA GLACIER/WHITTIER/ANCHORAGE:

Board the Glacier Queen II to sail to the face of Columbia Glacier, Alaska's most active tidewater glacier. Watch huge slabs of ice fall into the sea, filling the bay with icebergs. Then sail scenic Prince William Sound to the port of Whittier. Board a Westours motorcoach for the trip along Turnagain Arm to Anchorage.
